

To Hope and Back Culminating Project

Project Goal:

Instructions:

Part 1: Writing

- Choose either Sol or Lisa as the character you will be representing.
- Fill in the planner with entries for each of the dates provided. Remember to write from your character's perspective, not your own.
- Once your planner has been checked by your teacher, go on to Part 2.

Part 2: Map Preparation

- Trace the outline of the map onto your bristol board.
- Label the following only:
 - Canada
 - United States
 - Cuba
 - Germany
 - France
 - Great Britain
 - Belgium
 - Atlantic Ocean
- Draw a line across the ocean that shows the journey of the St. Louis.
- Create a label box that includes the following information:
 - *Sol's / Lisa's Journey on the St. Louis*
 - *May 13, 1939 - June 17, 1939*
 - *To Hope and Back by Kathy Kacer*

Part 3: Journal Entries

- Create a text box for each of your journal entries near the spot on the map where they happened.
- Add your edited journal entries to the map.
